#### Board of Director's Meeting Wednesday, August 13, 2008 Bill Rounds' home

Meeting came to order at 7:30PM with Jennifer Baker-Kennett, Charlie Cole, Bill Rounds, and Deb Danforth in attendance.

The Fair Gymkhanas were discussed – times not right in the fair flyers that have been distributed. Bill will get our flyers to Audrey to be mailed out with her Friday night event mailing. He will make sure he announces the correct time for the Labor Day event and that the 4H only one is on Friday night. The events for each of the gymkhanas were reviewed and some changes made. Deb will get the flyers done and posted on the web site.

Deb handed out a statement of the events the club has done so far this year, with the costs/profits. We talked about the success of the regional show. We talked about the Instate open show, the efforts to put it on and run it vs. the outcome. We about broke even on that event, but it has steadily declined over the years. Jenn wondered about adding some of the Instate Appaloosa and open classes into our regional show weekend and running both shows together at the same time/location. It would save on effort and add revenue to the whole event via campers, stalls, use of same judges. There are other regional clubs in New England that do the same thing. Everyone thought this sounded like a great option to try.

We would continue to reserve our weekend at the Rutland Fair grounds and instead of doing the Instate open show, we would use that for a clinic – either 1 or 2 days. That way we can keep our use agreement with the Rutland grounds.

The cost of the ribbons needed for the year was also discussed. There are several organizations that don't hand out ribbons anymore, they hand out vouchers or ribbons and you can turn them in for useful items – hooks, snaps, brushes, vet rap, travel toiletries, etc. These items could be purchases at tack auctions or tool sales or dollar stores. There are several exhibitors at both the Gymkhanas and shows that do not take ribbons, they give them back. We felt this was definitely something to try.

Deb updated the group on the change in the national ruling requiring just the President and Vice President must be members of the ApHC, the rest of the board should be members. That is a help to the number of clubs that have many board members who love the breed, but don't have the need to be a ApHC member.

The advance registration for the booth at Everything Equine is due on Friday the 15<sup>th</sup>. We discussed the participation this year and agreed although we may not have generated new members this year, it was definitely good exposure for us and the breed. We agreed to reserve a booth again for 2009. We can work on if we want to do a demo or not later.

It doesn't appear that there were any people volunteering to bring horses to Equine Affaire in MASS in November. So there may not be a live Appaloosa on display. They would still like to have an Appaloosa demo on Sat AM. The booth would be used to sell Appaloosa items and possibly display a life size Appaloosa model with Heritage costume. These expenses and profits would be shared with all the participating New England clubs. It is just such a hard time of year for everyone coupled with the price of gas. Those that live closer to the Big E make more sense to offer their horses.

Trail ride – We are still planning for October 5<sup>th</sup>. George has been scoping out the trails near his house – there are miles and miles. He has permission from the Austin farm to use their field for parking and access to the trails. We will have George continue to work on this and get info into a flyer format for distribution.
