6. No reruns will be allowed for falls of either horse or rider or for broken equipment.
7. No child/horse being led or walked beside of or in front of shall place over a child on his/his own. Guidance from a distance is allowed.
8. Disqualification will result in any event when corner markers are knocked over, or any object is knocked over, or when a rider touches either, in an attempt to prevent them from falling over.
9. In the event of a tie, a runoff will be held. The runoff may be won only after the pattern has been successfully completed within two seconds of the original time.
10. Riders will walk their horses to and from the ring. There will be no running of horses outside of the ring.
11. The committee reserves the right to combine divisions for lack of entries.

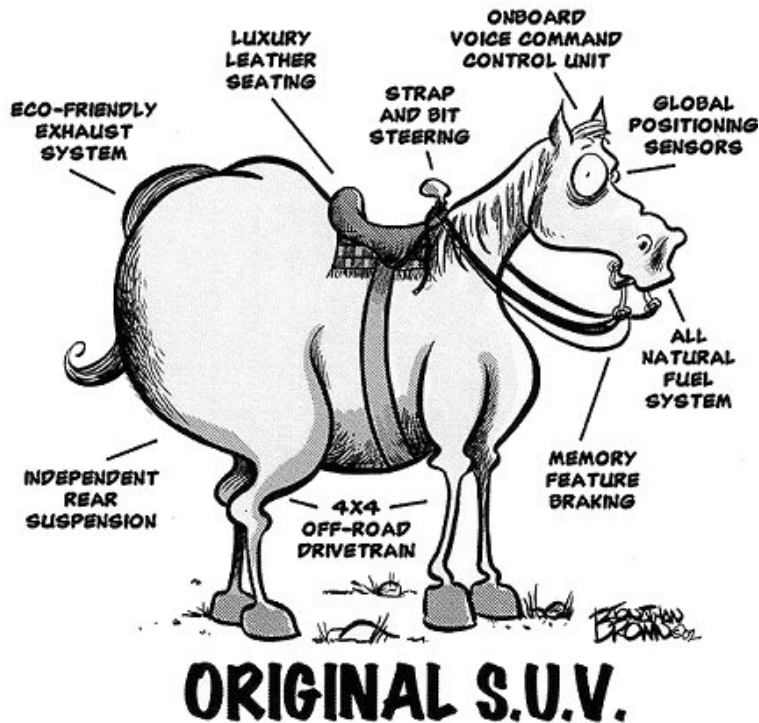

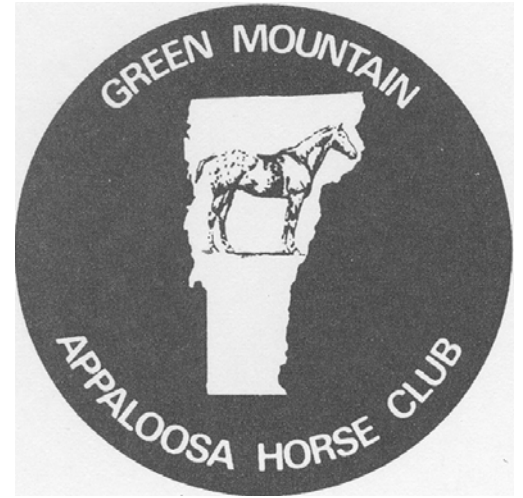
